SIKESTON BOOTHEEL CLASSIC INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT
TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIPS
NOVEMBER 3-5, 2006**

(Please Note: All Grades 1 & 2 teams will receive either trophies or participation awards. Kindergarten teams will be given participation awards only.)

Championships will be determined as follows:

- a) In an age group with five teams or less in their division a round robin format will be played. The team with the most points will be the champion and the team with the second most points will receive the second place trophies. There will be no championship game in following divisions: all **Black Divisions** (except **Boys Grade 4** and **High School**), **Boys Grade 3 Red Division**, **Girls Grades 1-2 Red Division** and **Girls Grades 7-8 Red Division**.
- b) Championship games will be played in age groups with 6 or more teams in their division. The combined total of teams in the "**EAST**", "**WEST**", "**NORTH**", "**SOUTH**", or "**CENTRAL**" brackets within a "division" determines the total number of teams within the division.
- c) In **Boys Grade 4 Red Division** and **Boys High School Black Division**, there are seven teams. Each team will play four games. The two teams with the most points will advance to the championship game.
- d) In **Boys Grade 4 Black Division**, there are six teams. Those teams are divided into two three-team brackets, referred to as East and West. These teams will play the other two teams in their respective divisions, resulting in 1st, 2nd and 3rd seeds. The high points East Bracket Winner (E1) will play the second highest points winner from the West Bracket (W2), and the West Bracket high points team (W1) will play the East Bracket's second highest points winner (E2) in two semi-final games. The winners will advance to the championship game. The third place teams from "East and West Brackets" will play each other for the consolation championship. (Trophies will be awarded for first and second place only in this division.)
- e) In **Girls Grades 3-4 Red Division**, there are eight teams. The teams are divided into two four-team brackets, referred to as East & West. Each team will play the other 3 teams in their respective bracket. The team with the most points in the East Bracket will play the team with the most points in the West Bracket for the division championship.

- f) In **Girls Grades 5-6 Red Division**, there are ten teams. The teams are divided into three brackets. The East and West Brackets have three teams and the Central Bracket has four teams. Each team will play the other teams in their respective Bracket. Teams in the East and West brackets will also each play one crossover game against a team in the other bracket. The team with the most points in each bracket will advance to semifinal games with a wild card team. The winners of those games will then play each other for the Division championship. The wildcard team will be the non-bracket winning team with the highest average points per game out of all three brackets combined.
- g) In **Boys Grades 7-8 Red Division** there are thirteen teams. These teams are divided into three brackets. The East and West Brackets have four teams, and the Central Bracket has five teams. The team with the most points in each bracket will advance to semifinal games with a wild card team. The winners of those games will then play each other for the Division championship. The wildcard team will be the non-bracket winning team with the highest average points per game out of all three brackets combined.
- h) In **Boys Grades 1-2 Red Division**, there are sixteen teams. Teams in the North and South Brackets will play three games and the winners of those two brackets will play in the semifinal game #1. The East and West Brackets will play three games with the winners of those two brackets playing in the semifinal game #2. The winners will advance to the championship game.
- i) In **Boys Grades 5-6 Red Division**, there are twelve teams split into three four-team brackets. The teams will each play three games, then the high points team from each bracket (EAST, WEST and CENTRAL) will advance with a wildcard team to the semifinals. The wildcard team will be the non-bracket winning team with the highest average points per game out of all three brackets combined.

In case of a tie within a division, the winner will be determined as listed in item number 3 in the tournament rules and regulations. Please note that teams losing a semi-final game in their division will each receive third place trophies.
